



2017 Platinum Block 2 Pinot Noir

THE VINTAGE

A wet spring led to a later start, however, the 2017 season was hotter and more compressed than normal. The season brought smaller berry size, clusters and yields. Fruit quality was excellent, characterized by high flavour concentration, moderate alcohol, balanced tannins, complexity and natural acidity

THE SITE

Block 2 sits on the lower slopes of our CedarCreek Home Block vineyard on Lakeshore Road in Kelowna. The block's clay soils originate from post-glacial sediment of the immense Lake Penticton, the ice age predecessor to Okanagan Lake. Our 27-year-old vines thrive in this terroir.

TASTING NOTES

Nice mouthfeel, fine dusty tannins. Red fruit and floral notes, with a hint of clove and minerality.
